

BROARDBAND INTERNET IN YOUR HOUSE SIGN UP NOW!!!

https://register.dtsfiber.com

DTS Fiber will be installing residential fiber connections from May-August 2024. Type your address into the website link above, then answer some questions, to let them know you would like to set up fiber at your house.

Things to know:

- This is a partnership between Washoe County and DTS Fiber; the County is covering the installation costs and pricing is set below market value for the next 5 years.
- To not pay for installation, you need to opt to have installation done during this initial period, If
 you choose to have installation done at a future time, it will likely cost in the \$150 range to have
 the connection installed.
- The silver package is \$49.99/month for 500mbps and is plenty for almost all residential uses (you can upgrade later to more bandwidth if needed). A modem comes with the package.
- You can add on your landline for \$9.99/month and/or Direct TV services for an additional cost. You can keep your current telephone number.
- There were some questions at the meeting of whether this is really better than the mediocre options Gerlach has had in the past. The answer is YES, fiber internet really is that much better. It's more reliable and faster than anything we have had before. It is better and cheaper than Starlink.
- The system could go down if one of the lines coming into Gerlach along 447 is broken. They will
 have a backup system in place, which will be slower but will allow limited connection (e.g., your
 phone line will work if you have one) until they can get it fixed. The fiber lines are not powered,
 so even if the power goes out, the fiber lines can still remain functional (though your internet
 devices need power, so there's that).
- The speed and reliability of the connection is NOT affected by the influx of people during Burning Man.
- The Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP) is currently NOT accepting new applications. If Congress renews the program, households that meet the income requirements can get a reduced cost for DTS fiber.
- If you could not make the meeting but have questions, DTS is happy to come back to Gerlach.


